Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are experiencing active Covid cases within the District at this time. In order to help minimize future cases and/or quarantine measures, I am asking you to take the following precautions at home:

- If anyone in your house tests positive for Covid, keep your child at home and contact their respective campus.
- If anyone in your house is being tested for Covid, keep your child at home until the test results are available. If a test is positive, your child will need to be set up for distance learning while quarantined. If a test is negative, your child may return to school.
- It is important to quarantine appropriately for the safety of others if you or your child have been exposed to someone with Covid.
- If there is any concern, for any reason, please contact the school, and we can administer a test to your child in the parking lot before your child enters the school building.
- Our testing kits are allotted for only students and staff.

Symptoms of COVID-19 including the following:

- Feeling feverish or temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
- Loss of taste or smell
- Cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Chills, shaking or exaggerated shivering
- Sore throat, congestion or runny nose
- Significant muscle pain or ache
- Diarrhea, nausea or vomiting
