Dear Parent/Guardian,

We are notifying all student families that we received notification today that an elementary student has tested positive for COVID-19. The individual was last present on the campus on November 30, 2020. Out of an abundance of caution, students in grades 2 and 6 have been quarantined for 14 days. Students who do not develop symptoms of COVID-19 infection may return to campus on December 14, 2020. If your child exhibits COVID-19 symptoms, please contact Linda McCulloch, School Nurse at 979-249-3200 to discuss return. Due to privacy requirements, we will not release the name of the individual or details that may identify him or her.

We are working closely with the local health department on this matter. In addition, extra sanitation/cleaning measures have been implemented.

We advise you to monitor your health, follow the CDC guidelines and contact your primary care physician if you develop symptoms, as well as our school nurse, Linda McCulloch, at 979-249-3200.

For this reason, we ask that all individuals continue to watch for symptoms of COVID-19 including the following:

- Feeling feverish or temperature greater than or equal to 100.0 degrees Fahrenheit
- Loss of taste or smell
- Cough, shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Headache
- Chills, shaking or exaggerated shivering
- Sore throat, congestion or runny nose
- Significant muscle pain or ache
- Diarrhea, nausea or vomiting

Round Top-Carmine ISD is continuing to monitor this situation and will provide additional information as needed. We hope for a successful recovery for our RT-C student.
