TEA is requiring all public schools to conduct internal and external safety audits to evaluate if all instructional facilities are in compliance with the School Safety Standards. After completing the audits, Round Top-Carmine ISD will be making the following changes to its instructional facilities this summer:

- increasing all external fencing to eight feet
- reinforcing all windows outside of the external fencing with entry-resistant film
- installation of panic alert system
- installation of electronic door system at the high school campus main office entry to match the current system at the elementary campus

RT-C ISD received \$199,000 in grant money from the state to complete the changes listed above. All of the projects will be able to be completed with the amount the district received through the grant, and the changes to the instructional facilities will not require the district to use the current budget or money received from taxes.
