Chromebook Agreement

This document provides information about Chromebooks, procedures relative to loss or damage to the Chromebook and other expectations. Use of a Chromebook, like any other use of District Technology, is governed by the District's Use of Technology Policy (Student Handbook), which students and their parents/guardians are responsible for reviewing and understanding.

Round Top-Carmine students and their parent/guardian must sign the Chromebook Agreement and return the completed form in order to receive a Chromebook device and power cord. These items will not be issued without a student and parent/guardian signature. Inappropriate use of District technology may result in limited or banned computer use and/or disciplinary action, as outlined in the RT-C Student Handbook.

Chromebook Understandings

- The Chromebook 1:1 Learning device is the property of Round Top-Carmine ISD.
- Round Top-Carmine ISD has the right to collect, inspect and/or alter the device at any time.
- Users of RT-C ISD technology have no rights, ownership, or expectations of privacy to any data that is, or was, stored on the Chromebook, school network, or any school-issued applications.
- There are no guarantees that said data will be retained and may be destroyed. Student data is hosted in the Google cloud; RT-C ISD is not responsible for data loss.

Chromebook Care and Responsibilities

The student is responsible for making sure he/she has a fully operational Chromebook while at school.

Students must:

- comply, at all times, with the Use of Technology Policy as described in the Student Handbook when using their Chromebook.
- bring their Chromebook fully charged to school every day.
- keep their device clean, treat their device with care and never leave it in an unsecured location. (Theft from an unlocked vehicle or unsecured area is not insured by the District.)
- assume sole responsibility for any apps or extensions on their Chromebook that are not installed by a member of the RT-C ISD staff.
- promptly report any problems with their Chromebook to the building principal Mr. Bathke.
- not attempt to install any operating system on the Chromebook.
- not remove or deface the serial number and other identification tags.
- not attempt to remove or change the physical structure of the Chromebook

Chromebook Repairs and Insurance Coverage

Optional insurance can be taken out on your Chromebook for accidental damage.

Coverage is an annual \$20.00 nonrefundable fee. (Please make checks out to RT-C ISD)

Your deductible cost escalates if more than one accident occurs.

- Accidental Damage Repair/Deductible Charges
 - 1st Occurrence - no charge
 - 2nd Occurrence - \$50 or cost of actual repair, whichever is less
 - 3rd Occurrence - \$110 or cost of repair, whichever is less
 - 4th and Subsequent Occurrences - \$180 or cost of repair, whichever is less
- Insurance does not pertain to lost or stolen Chromebooks. If a Chromebook is lost or stolen, the student and parents are responsible for the cost of replacement.

- If you choose not to accept insurance, these are the estimated replacement costs (lost, stolen, or unrepairable due to negligence)
 - Charger - \$ 20
 - Cracked or damaged screen - \$ 50
 - Total Device Loss/Unrepairable (with or without charger) - \$185

Failure to return a Chromebook at the end of the school year or time of departure from RT-C school district will result in holding student's transcripts and/or diploma until device is returned or fees paid.

By signing below, the student and his/her parent/guardian agree that they have read and understood the Round Top-Carmine ISD Acceptable Use Policy and Student Handbook, that they agree to follow and be bound by the guidelines above as well as all other applicable District policies and procedures. The student and his/her parent/guardian agree that the District owns the Chromebook, management software and peripherals and that if the student ceases to be enrolled in Round Top-Carmine ISD for any reason, the Chromebook and issued peripherals must be returned to the District in good working order or full replacement cost will be charged to the student and his/her parent/guardian.
